Gareth Jones is a chartered planner with over 20 years' experience working across the public and private sectors. He specialises in heritage, townscape and urban design.

He began his career at Chester City Council before working as a conservation and design officer at a number of London Boroughs including Hammer-smith and Fulham and Westminster City Council, where he managed the production of Conservation Area Audits. As a design review advisor at CABE his case load included a number of high profile projects across the UK and he contributed to a number of publications including Design Reviewed Retail. One of his first tasks as the Urban Design and Conservation Manager at the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames was to set up a design review panel.

Gareth has worked on a wide range of projects in the private sector, and has acted as expert witness in respect of heritage and design matters at many public inquiries.

At Peter Stewart Consultancy Gareth's focus is on schemes in London with heritage considerations and projects that include tall buildings, such as the Shell Centre redevelopment. As well as schemes in Canary Wharf, Shoreditch and Battersea, Gareth has worked on large scale redevelopments such as Audley Square House in Mayfair, and 21–31 New Oxford Street. Other projects involve sensitive heritage assets, including the new library at Lambeth Palace, and the extension to the Royal Opera House and the Wellington Hotel site in Covent Garden.

Gareth was on the CABE Planning Advisory Committee, and has served as a CABE Enabler and as a member of the Southwark Design Panel.
